Hi Jack,

On 11 August, I posted the below notice on the VFW Post 2485 Facebook page. Yesterday we had booked 3 vans to take 15 persons to the VA Clinic, but only 13 actually showed up and went to get their vaccine. So far, we got 3 persons signed-up to go next Monday 23 August. Please share the below information with anyone interested in joining the roundtrip group transportation (cost 4,500 pesos, which is shared equally among passengers) which we are arranging for individuals going from SM Clark City to the VA Clinic for the Walk-in vaccine on Mondays and the weekend of September 11 and 12:

**GROUP TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE WILL BE ARRANGED ONLY FOR PERSONS GOING TO THE VA CLINIC FOR THE WALK-IN VACCINE ON MONDAYS AND THE WEEKEND OF SEP. 11 & 12:**

The VA Clinic Walk-in vaccine is from 9am to 11am from now until 21 September. To keep matters simple, VFW Post 2485 will offer to book group transportation on a cost sharing basis to attend the VA Clinic Walk-in vaccine only on Mondays starting August 16 until Monday September 20. We will also offer to book group transportation on the weekend of September 11 and 12 for individuals going for the Walk-in vaccine.

This is the easiest and most efficient way for us to help you and others get vaccinated on any of the following 8 dates to receive the Walk-in vaccine:

- Monday - 16 August
- Monday - 23 August
- Monday - 30 August
- Monday - 6 September
- Saturday - 11 September
- Sunday - 12 September
- Monday - 13 September
- Monday - 20 September

The cost for the roundtrip group transportation in a Toyota Hi-Ace Grandia van to the VA Clinic Manila from SM Clark City is 4,500 pesos, which will be equally shared among the passengers in the van. The VA Clinic requires two (2) valid IDs to enter the facility,

one ID should be your VA Healthcare card or U.S. Armed Forces ID card (CAC, DD Form 2 or DD Form 1173).

If you want to join the group transportation arranged by us, YOU MUST RESERVE A SEAT so that we can book the appropriate number of vans. To reserve a seat in a van going to the VA Clinic Walk-in vaccine on any of the above listed dates, please provide the following information:

1. Your first and last name.
2. Are you registered as a patient at the VA Clinic Manila?
3. What is your VA eligibility status to receive the vaccine?
  - a. If self-sponsored Veteran, please provide branch of service, Active, Retired, Guard/Reserve and your length of service.
  - b. If spouse, widow or domestic partner, please provide the full name, contact information and status (Active, Retired, etc.) of your sponsor.
4. Your Email address.
5. Your Mobile phone number.
6. The date you want to get the Walk-in vaccine.
  - a. Deadline to book a seat on Monday is Saturday preceeding the Monday.
  - b. The deadline to book a seat for Sep. 11 or 12 is Sep. 9.

Electronic sign-ups will receive an electronic confirmation of their request to book a seat(s) and on the day of the respective deadline to sign-up, a mass email will be sent out to everyone in the particular group with exact details on when and where to meet the vans at SM Clark.
