WHAT YOU NEED TO DO IF YOU DON'T HAVE A SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT WITHIN THE NEXT 30 DAYS AND YOU WANT TO RECEIVE COVID19 VACCINE:

Submit a request to <https://ask.va.gov/> by Friday December 1, 2023. The information you will provide will help us determine the number of vaccines we need to request.
